- 4. Entrants can be residents of any country. Only East African Entrants receive free entry.
- 5. An entry fee of \$10 or more to be paid via link at www.umojawritingcomp.wordpress.com direct to the Umoja Orphanage Kenya project.
- 6. Name of entrant can only appear on the cover sheet and not anywhere on the story.
- 7. The judges' decision will be final. No correspondence will be entered into. No entries will be returned.
- 8. Only the short list will be informed of the results, which will be posted on the Umoja Writing Comp, Umoja and Warm and Witty Words websites. Soon after the winner will be announced
- 9. Winners will be announced on all websites on or after October 2016. Winners will be notified by email. Each entry must contain: 1. Entry Form 2. Entry Fee and proof of payment 3. Cover Sheet 4. Entry.
